

## God is Omnipresent

Psalm 139:7-10; Jeremiah 23:23-24

May 8, 2022

### I. God is Everywhere Present

- A. The doctrine of Omnipresence says that God is present in every part of His universe
  - 1. Since God is Spirit He is not constrained by spatial barriers
  - 2. He is present in His being in all of creation
- B. The scriptures point to the scope of God's presence (Psalm 139:7-10)
  - 1. He is present on Heaven
  - 2. He is present in the lowest point for man
  - 3. There is nowhere that God does not exist

### II. He is present in highest point in Heaven

- A. He transcends our power and ability to understand
  - 1. The finite cannot comprehend the infinite
  - 2. We are not called to understand everything about God, but rather believe everything about God
- B. God rules from the highest place
  - 1. His throne is situated in the heavens (Psalm 123:1)
  - 2. He rules the earth and is exalted about any other perceived God (Psalm 97:9)
  - 3. His throne is high and lifted up (Isaiah 6:1)
  - 4. His throne room is in heaven (Rev 4:1-2)
- C. As believers we should know and believe that God is in absolute control and at work our lives
  - 1. We are never out of His reach
  - 2. We are never out of His thoughts

### III. He is present near the Earth

- A. Scripture affirms that God is committed to His people & His creation
  - 1. He is with us in the throws of dying (Psalm 23:4)
  - 2. He is present on earth and in heaven (Deuteronomy 4:39)
  - 3. He is with us in the our highest and lowest moments (Isaiah 57:15)
- B. Even if we are forsaken by man, He will never abandon us (Hebrews 13:5)

### IV. He is present in the Depths of Hell

- A. God administers the divine wrath that is hell
  - 1. We are told that punishment takes place in the presence of angels and Lamb (Rev 14:10)
  - 2. He will be very real to those that experience His judgment there
  - 3. Although present, His gaze of blessing will be turned away

### V. The Outcome of God's Omnipresence for Man

- A. His omnipresence offers encouragement to His children
  - 1. He is with us in the midst of trials and adversity in life
  - 2. He is committed to His own
  - 3. God is omnipresent and Satan is not
- B. His omnipresence offers a grave warning
  - 1. Those that oppose God can ultimately never flee Him
  - 2. Though all experience the common grace of God, those that do not respond in faith will experience His divine wrath
