I. Our Salvation is Secure Because of the Author of Our Salvation (v. 11)

- A. Salvation comes from the God the Father
 - It starts with the God loving us first (I John 4:10; I John 4:14)
 - God always draws the sinner to Himself
- B. Salvation comes through the Son – Jesus
 - We are saved through the work of Jesus Christ (John 3:16-17)
 - We are delivered to eternal life fully through Christ (John 14:6)
- C. Salvation comes by the Spirit
 - The Spirit brings conviction upon the sinner (John 16:8)
 - The Spirit completes our conversion by the indwelling (Titus 3:5-7)
 - The Spirit brings about the New Man (Titus 3:5)

- C. We must Receive The gift of salvation (Col. 2:6; John 1:11-12)
 - Our receiving is not about allowing him in our life
 - Our receiving Him is about submitting our life to Him

- A. It is always dependent on God holding on to us (John 10:27-29)
 - You are adopted into God's family
 - You are bought with the price of His Son's blood
- B. It is a fact we cannot be separated from God's love (Romans 8:38-39)
- C. The Holy Spirit's indwelling can never be severed (Eph. 1:13-14)
 - God has invested His Spirit into our lives as a guarantee
 - Nothing can ever displace the Holy Spirit
